Living in the Freedom Christ Has Given Us | **Galatians 5:1**

It is for [] that Christ has set us [].
Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a [].

1. Welcome

“When do you feel the most free these days?”

Share one grace or blessing you received through Grace Time this past week.

2. Sermon Summary

Although we may enjoy freedom in our daily lives, we can still easily become spiritually bound by sin and temptation. Today’s passage speaks of the deeper, true freedom that Jesus Christ gives us. What is this freedom, and how can we truly live in it?

① Jesus has set us free from [] and [].

We cannot break the chains of [] and [] by our own strength. Only through the cross and resurrection of Jesus can we become children of God and experience true freedom.

② Jesus gives us freedom from [].

We are not made righteous by keeping [], but are justified through faith in Jesus Christ. When we rely not on our own works but solely on the blood of Christ shed on the cross, we are freed from the heavy yoke of the law and can experience true freedom.

③ Jesus gives believers freedom from [] and [].

Even after we are saved, the spiritual battle continues. But the power to overcome sin does not come from our own willpower; it comes from the power of the Holy Spirit who lives within us.

True freedom from long-standing sinful habits does not come through our own willpower, but only through our union with Jesus Christ. Therefore, we must let go of relying on our own strength, depend on the Holy Spirit, and abide in the Lord.

The true freedom we receive through the gospel is not the freedom to live however we please, but the freedom to live a holy life, serving God and others in love. As we walk this path of loving service, we will continue to experience the true freedom the Lord has given us

3. Discussion
