The faith of one family can save a nation | **2 Chronicles 23:9-11**
(9) Then he gave the commanders of units of a hundred the spears and the large and small shields that had belonged to King David and that were in the temple of God. **(10)** He stationed all the men, each with his weapon in his hand, around the king--near the altar and the temple, from the south side to the north side of the temple. **(11)** Jehoiada and his sons brought out the king's son and put the crown on him; they presented him with a copy of the covenant and proclaimed him king. They anointed him and shouted, "Long live the king!"

2. Sermon Summary

During Athaliah’s attempt to destroy David’s royal line, the priest Jehoiada and his wife courageously risked their lives to protect the young prince Joash. Hidden in the temple for six years, Joash was eventually crowned king, restoring the rightful line of David. This story reminds us that God’s covenant never fails. Even in the darkest times, He faithfully preserves His plan of salvation through people and families who trust Him.

① Faith That Protects Life in Times of Crisis

Jehoiada and his wife trusted God’s promise and risked everything to preserve the future of His kingdom. Their faith became the spark that ended a dark chapter in Israel’s history and brought spiritual renewal.

② Faith That Builds God’s Kingdom

For six years, Jehoiada patiently waited for God’s timing while carefully preparing for Joash’s coronation. Likewise, when we are confident of God’s calling, we should not act impulsively but faithfully make practical plans and carry them out through ministry, missions, and service.

③ Faith That Remains Faithful to the End

Jehoiada faithfully guided and supported Joash throughout his life. In the same way, we are called to remain steadfast in God’s work, standing firm through every challenge and serving Him faithfully to the end.
