Three Spiritual Blessings Brought by the Power of God's Word | Psalm 19:7-14

(7) The law of the LORD is (), () the soul. The statutes of the LORD are (), making () the simple ... (9) The fear of the LORD is (), enduring (). 2. Sermon Summary

The purpose of today's Bible Quiz is to draw closer to God's Word, learn from it, and live according to it. God's Word is living and gives life to our souls. It gives us wisdom and discernment and guides us on the right path. **Let us look together at three spiritual blessings that come through the power of God's Word.**

① The Blessings of () and ().

(Psalm 19:7) The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul

God's Word gives life to our souls and restores us when we are weary and spiritually dry. It also reveals our faults, leading us to turn from the wrong path and return to God. As we draw near to God's Word each day, hold firmly to it, and obey it, our souls and our lives are renewed and transformed.

② The Blessings of () and ().

(Psalm 19:7-8) The statutes of the LORD are trustworthy, making wise the simple. ... The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes

God's Word opens our spiritual eyes and gives us the wisdom to discern what is right and wrong. Even in a confusing world, when we make God's Word our standard, we can choose the right path that pleases Him. Therefore, we should become wise believers who stay close to God's Word and make our judgments and choices according to it in every moment of life.

③ The Blessings of () and ().

(Psalm 19:9, 11) The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. ... in keeping them there is great reward

God's Word transforms our values so that we look not to the temporary things of this world, but to the eternal kingdom of God. When we live according to His Word, we choose a holy life of eternal value that pleases God rather than pursuing worldly success. Therefore, as we obey His Word and live for His kingdom, God remembers our faithfulness and gives us a great reward.

May you draw near to God's Word every day, experience the restoration of your soul, gain wisdom and discernment, and live for the eternal kingdom of God.
