Who Am I Helping to Shine? | Proverbs 27:17

*As iron sharpens iron,
so one person sharpens another.*

1. Welcome

“Who is someone I would most like to compliment these days?”
What grace from Grace Time stood out to you this past week?

2. Sermon Summary

Just as iron sharpens iron, Scripture tells us that one person sharpens another. God uses one another to refine us and help us grow. At times, we offer counsel, make up for one another's weaknesses, and help each other become wiser and more mature. To build others up and help them shine, we need humility and respect. Respect means recognizing and valuing the worth and role God has given each person.

1. Let Us Respect and Build One Another Up at Home

The closer the relationship, the easier it is to lose respect. Instead of focusing on each other's shortcomings, couples should recognize and encourage one another's strengths and efforts. Through loving counsel and mutual support, they can grow together. Our words can either discourage those closest to us or help them shine. People flourish when they are respected.

2. Let Us Respect and Build One Another Up in the Church and Ministry Community (Eph. 2:21; 4:16)

The church is a community of people with different gifts and backgrounds. We grow together by respecting one another's value and roles, offering loving counsel, and supporting one another. Humility means considering others above us. Ministry leaders should connect and build people up, helping each person fulfill their God-given gifts and roles. Small acts of service, words of affirmation, and humble respect help one another shine and strengthen the whole community.

3. Let Us Respect and Build One Another Up in the Workplace

The workplace is where our Christian respect and humility are tested daily. Even in a competitive environment, we should recognize others' efforts and values, learn from their strengths, and support one another. When we choose words that build up rather than tear down, we help one another grow and shine.

At home, church, and work, we are “iron” for one another. Through humble respect, we build each other up and help one another shine. May our families, house churches, groups, ministries, and workplaces become communities that value and strengthen one another.
