It Is Time to Go Back Up to Bethel | Gen. 35:1-15

(1) Go up to () and build an altar there. (2) Get rid of the () among you, () yourselves, and change your (). (3) Let us go up to Bethel, where I will build an () to God.

1. Welcome

"When was a time in your faith journey that you would love to go back to?"
What grace or blessing from Grace Time stood out to you most this past week?

2. Sermon Summary

When Jacob's family faced a crisis, God told him, "Go up to Bethel." Bethel was where Jacob had first encountered God and received His promise. God did not tell Jacob to run from his problems, but to return to Him. The restoration of our families, church, and generation also begins by returning to God. Putting God back in the highest place in our lives and fearing Him—this is the way back to Bethel.

1. Prepare with ()

(Gen. 35:2) "Get rid of the foreign gods among you, purify yourselves, and change your clothes."

Jacob told his family to get rid of their foreign gods and purify themselves. Anything we rely on or love more than God can become an idol. To fear God is to treasure Him above all else and let go of what does not please Him. True restoration begins with repentance.

2. Make a () of Faith

(Gen. 35:5) God caused great fear to fall on the towns around them.

The road to Bethel did not look safe, but Jacob trusted God's Word and set out. Faith that fears God puts His Word above our circumstances. Even when the way ahead is uncertain and we are afraid, we hold on to His Word and obey. That is the safest path.

3. Fulfill Your ()

(Gen. 35:7) There he built an altar and called the place El Bethel.

Jacob arrived at Bethel, built an altar, and kept the promise he had made to God. Those who fear God value the promises and commitments they have made to Him. We, too, must remember the grace we have received and restore our first faith and commitment.

Now is the time to go back up to Bethel. Let us lay down the idols in our hearts, repent, obey God's Word, and restore our first commitment. As we return to God, may His restoration come upon our families, our church, and this land.

3. Discussion

- 1) What part of today's message, "It Is Time to Go Back Up to Bethel," spoke to you the most?
- 2) Like Jacob at Bethel, when was a time you encountered God deeply? What grace did you receive, and what commitment did you make?
- 3) If you were to go back up to Bethel today, what do you need to lay down, and what faith and commitment do you need to restore?
