Family church worship plan 2026. 1. 25

1st Week of February: The Decisive Battle of Faith is Spiritual Warfare.(Ephesians 6:10-18)

Welcome

What scene, testimony, or word from this revival meeting touched your heart the most? Let's share. Also, let's share one of the gracious things we received through last week's Grace Time.

Text: Ephesians 6:10-18

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. 13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. 14 Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, 15 and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. 16 In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. 17 Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. 18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.

Introduction

The decisive move of faith is spiritual warfare. Satan, the devil, and the forces of darkness constantly seek to deceive believers and tempt them to fall away from the path of faith. Peter, who had fallen to the devil's power, urges us to resist the devil by being alert and standing firm in faith.

(1 Peter 5:8-9) “Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. 9 Resist him, standing firm in the faith...”

The devil put the thought of betraying Jesus into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Jesus's disciple. The devil attacks through our thoughts. Furthermore, anxiety, worry, concern, and fear in our hearts are entry points for Satan. Our hearts and minds must be guarded in the Lord.

(Philippians 4:6-7) “Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”

Now we must make the decisive move of faith to rise again as victors, not as defeated.

Observation Question: What is the decisive move of faith for victory in spiritual warfare?

Answer 1. Be strong and courageous - Arm yourself with the blood of Jesus

The first attitude for victory in spiritual warfare is strength and courage. This courage does not come from human conviction or slogans, but only through the power of Jesus's blood. The blood of Jesus's cross has freed us from the law of sin and death that held us down.

(Romans 8:2) "Because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death."

Moreover, through the blood of Jesus, believers receive forgiveness of sins and are delivered from the power of darkness, gaining the authority to be 'children of God.' Our citizenship is in heaven, and when we are confident and believe that we are children of God, we can subdue the forces of Satan and the devil 'in the name of Jesus Christ.'

(John 1:12) "Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God."

(Colossians 1:13) "For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves."

The struggle between Isaac's sons, Jacob and Esau, was not a fight of flesh and blood. Jacob sought reconciliation with Esau by sending herds of livestock ahead, but it was through Jacob's wrestling at the Jabbok River that he ultimately won Esau's heart. It was a spiritual battle. The closed doors and unresolved matters in our lives are opened and resolved through the power of Jesus Christ's blood.

Application Question 1

- 1) Share about a time when you prayed boldly as a child of God, relying on the Lord's blood.
- 2) What prayer request would you like to pray for boldly together, relying on the Lord's blood?

Answer 2. Obey God's Word (Verse 12)

The weapons of spiritual warfare are not of the flesh but are divine power to demolish strongholds. Therefore, equipping oneself with 'the helmet of salvation, the breastplate of righteousness, the belt of truth, and the shield of faith'—that is, being fully armored—means clothing oneself with Jesus Christ. Also, the gospel shoes will make those who wear them victorious in establishing God's kingdom wherever they go, trampling on the serpent's head. Victory in spiritual warfare is guaranteed when we put on the full armor.

Those who wear the full armor must have the heart of Christ. They must live as those who have received a heart transplant with Jesus's heart, like the Apostle Paul's passionate missionary heart. The church is a community of believers who live with Jesus's heart, making the Great Commission that Jesus gave us our life's purpose.

(Matthew 28:19-20) "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Application Question 2

- 1) Which part of God's full armor do you think you need to strengthen more this year?
- 2) How will you train yourself for that?

Answer 3. Take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

The final offensive weapon of God's full armor is 'the sword of the Spirit (the Word).' The Word is Jesus Christ himself. Jesus is the bread of life that came down from heaven.

(John 6:51) "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

The Word, which is the bread of life, is not merely knowledge in the head but 'the bread of life' that must fill our belly and intestines. Therefore, all the promises of Scripture become reality in our lives through Jesus Christ.

(Hebrews 4:12) "For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart."

The 66 books of the Bible are a record about Jesus Christ. When we consume this Word as 'the word of truth' through the illumination of the Holy Spirit, the power to penetrate and divide soul and spirit, joints and marrow is manifested.

The weapon of spiritual warfare against the forces of Satan and the devil is not of the flesh. We can only win spiritual warfare through God's power—Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit. Therefore, through the prayers and praise of believers, the work of the Holy Spirit's anointing must arise so that the Word is revealed and the blockages in our lives are released.

Application Question 3

- 1) What is the condition of your sword of the Spirit, the Word? (Have you been using it frequently? Is it ready?)
- 2) How do you plan to prepare this year to win with the sword of the Spirit? (worship meditation, through-reading, transcription, memorization, Bible quiz, etc.)
