# 4th Week of June: Qualities of a Great Father According to the Bible (Ephesians 6:4)

#### ■ Welcome

Let's share a really fun memory with your father. Also, let's share one of the blessings received through Grace Time last week.

#### ■ Text: Ephesians 6:4

And, fathers, do not provoke your children to anger; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

#### ■ Introduction

The presence of a father in the home is so important. Statistics show that children in families without fathers are more likely to suffer from various emotional problems such as anxiety, depression, and social withdrawal, and are significantly more likely to suffer from poverty, drug and alcohol abuse, school dropout, and health problems.

However, children who have close relationships with their fathers are twice as likely to have stable jobs, 75% less likely to get pregnant as teenagers, 80% less likely to go to prison, and half as likely to experience multiple episodes of depression.

Fathers are a precious gift from God to the family, and they are truly precious. Let's look at the importance of fathers because families need them to survive.

### ■ Observation Question: What does the Bible say about fathers?

# Answer 1. Fathers are spiritual guides and teachers to their children.

(Eph 6:4) "Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord."

A good father is primarily responsible for teaching his children the Word of God and the truth, and he guides them through his life example. Since a father's actions, honesty, and devotion to God are a living model of faith for his children, he should make his relationship with God the top priority in his life and be a strong spiritual example for his family.



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#### \* Specific ways fathers can raise their children with the Word

1) Read and share short Bible verses together

This is a practice that helps God's Word naturally permeate daily life.

2) Answer children's questions biblically:

This helps them develop a perspective on the world from a faith perspective.

3) Create a time for family worship and prayer

Have a time when the whole family gathers together at least once a week to praise, pray, and share a short message. This becomes an important habit that establishes the family as a small worship community.

#### \* What are the specific practices that fathers can take to model faith?

- 1) Show an example of an honest and sincere life: Show your children that you keep even small promises, take responsibility for your work, and do not lose your honesty even in difficult situations.
- 2) **Have an attitude of gratitude and humility**: Be grateful for small things, acknowledge your own shortcomings, and show humility by listening to others.
- 3) Show them that you admit mistakes and ask for forgiveness: When your children make a mistake, admit it honestly and ask for forgiveness. Also, teach them how to deal with sin by repenting to God.
- 4) Keep a consistent personal devotional time: Show them that 'faith is the priority in life.'
- 5) Have Sunday worship and service together as a family: Take Sunday service for granted, and share the joy of worshiping and serving in church with your children.

### Answer 2. Fathers are providers of love and mercy to their children.

(Eph 5:25) "Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her."

A biblical father is called to serve his family with sacrificial love. He must love his wife especially deeply, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her. This kind of love becomes a powerful example of faith for his children.

A good father is not just a material provider. He cares for the emotional and spiritual well-being of his children, praying for them, embracing their pains, needs, and dreams, and encouraging them.

- 1) Respecting and expressing love for his wife
- 2) Empathizing and supporting his children's feelings
- 3) Spending time together and sharing his heart



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- 4) Building confidence with specific praise and recognition
- 5) Respecting and supporting his children's dreams

# Answer 3. A father is a wise and gracious disciplinarian to his children.

(Hebrews 12:7) "For your patience is for discipline, for God deals with you as with sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline?"

- \* Important principles to keep in mind when disciplining.
- 1) Set consistent rules and make them follow them Set clear and understandable household rules for your children, and apply them consistently
- 2) Explain the consequences

When your children misbehave, rather than getting emotionally angry, calmly explain why the behavior was wrong and what the possible consequences will be.

3) Treat your children as individuals: Respect the dignity of your children when disciplining them.

# Answer 4. A father is a humble and friendly friend to his children.

Fathers should be deeply involved in their children's lives, making it a priority to be intentionally present and close to them. They should also never stop learning, growing every day, and living a life completely dependent on God. These are the true fathers who leave their children a legacy of faith and character. Fathers are not simply caregivers; they are entrusted with a mission from God. When they fulfill this mission with faith, prayer, and love, God will reward and glorify them.
