Revival Comes When the Dividing Wall is Broken Down | **Ephesians 2:14-18**

(14)For he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, (15)by setting aside in his flesh the law with its commands and regulations. His purpose was to create in himself one new humanity out of the two, thus making peace, (16)and in one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility. (17)He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near. (18)For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.

1. Welcome

"How many people did you have a genuine conversation with for at least 10 minutes this past week?" Share one grace or blessing you received through Grace Time this past week.

2. Sermon Summary

God wants His people to live in peace and joy. But sin creates walls between us and God, and between one another, breaking our relationships. Through the cross, Jesus tore down those walls, reconciled us to God, and brought us together as one. Today, let's look at three ways God breaks down the walls that divide us.

① () breaks down dividing walls.

Through the cross, Jesus tore down the wall of sin that separated us from God and from one another. But when we don't (), sin creates barriers between us and God and fills our hearts with hurt and bitterness. As we examine our hearts and () each day, those walls come down, and God's peace and joy are restored in our lives.

② () breaks down dividing walls.

While we were still sinners, God () us first and reached out to us with His love. As those who have received His (), we are called to () others and seek reconciliation. When we choose (), the walls between us come down, and God's grace and peace flow freely once again.

③ () breaks down dividing walls.

God desires our () more than our feelings. It is not easy to forgive first, seek reconciliation, or reach out to others. But when we () His Word, God tears down the walls between us and restores our relationships. As we live in (), our families and churches will be filled with His peace and grace, and true revival will begin.

Revival begins when the walls in our hearts come down.

It starts with (), grows through (), and is shown by ().

When we are reconciled with God and with one another, revival and peace will fill our families, our churches, and our lives.

3. Discussion

- 1) What spoke to you the most from today's message, "Revival Comes When the Dividing Wall Is Broken Down"?
- 2) What "wall" in your heart is keeping you from a closer relationship with God or with others?
(Examples: pride, prejudice, past hurts, unforgiveness, busyness, indifference, selfishness, fear of rejection, comparison, or difficulty communicating.)
- 3) It is not the world that hinders revival, but the walls we have built in our hearts. What is one step of obedience you can take this week to tear down that wall?

After the discussion, let's spend time in united prayer.
